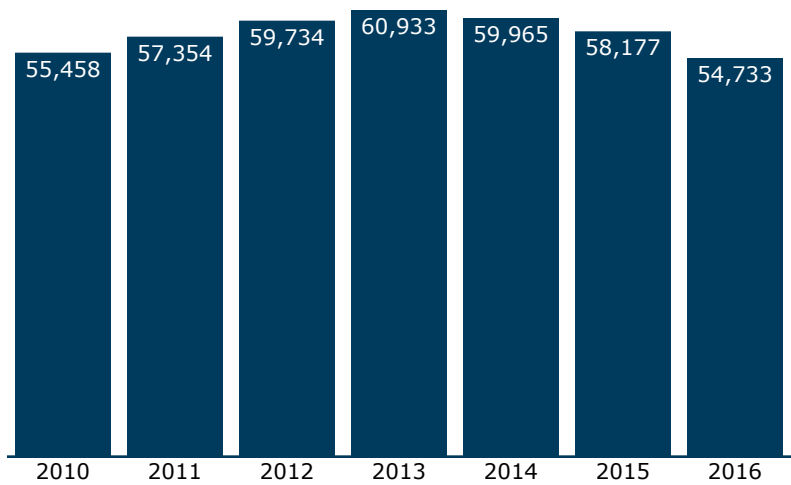


## Passengers using this station, 2010-2016

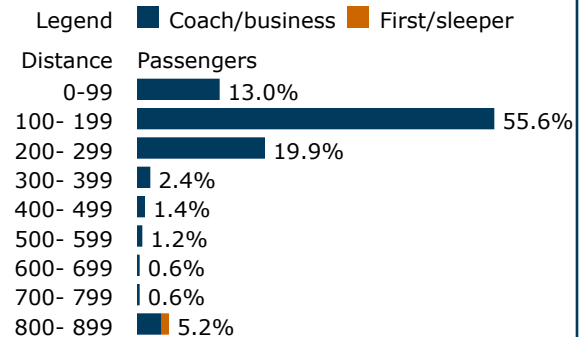
