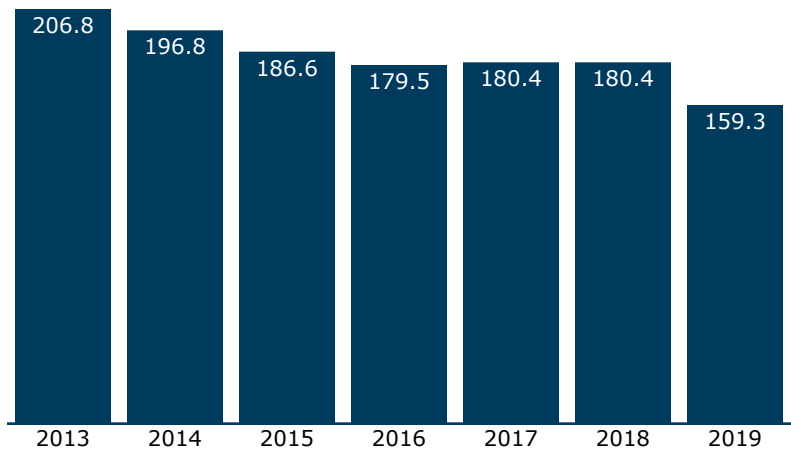


# Amtrak fact sheet: Louisiana, district 2
